Gloria Bachmann, MD is the Interim Chair in the Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Sciences, a Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and a Professor of Medicine at Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School (RWJMS), and the Obstetrics and Gynecology Service Chief at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, New Brunswick, New Jersey. Also at RWJMS she is the Director of the Women's Health Institute and the Associate Dean for Women's Health. For her expertise in mentoring and teaching, she also is a member of the Rutgers Master Educators' Guild. In these professional roles, Dr. Bachmann is actively involved in the teaching and the clinical practice of medicine as well as in the research aspects as it pertains to women's health and wellness. She is an internationally known expert in the field of women's health and has over 150 peer reviewed publications and over 30 chapters. She has a long history of being the principal and co-principal investigator on several clinical trials, with her research advancing the field of menopause, female pain syndromes, sexual function, obstetrical safety and vaginal health. One of the current areas she is focusing on is the topic of maternal safety and the role of the patient and her family. Data derived from her participation in multiple research trials has added extensively to the literature and to many advances in the field of women's health.
