



George W. Mulheron, PhD

Dr. Mulheron is a classically trained gross anatomist with over 20 years of teaching experience in medical education at UMDNJ, now Rutgers. Dr. Mulheron is course director for the M1 Structure and Function course and co-block director of the Foundations in Biomedical Science block as well as the anatomy content expert for the M1 curriculum. Dr. Mulheron has directed graduate level courses in anatomy for UMDNJ-SHRP Physician Assistant and Physical Therapy programs and currently directs the Gross Anatomy course for the Rutgers-GSBS Masters program.

In 2001, Dr. Mulheron was appointed to head the RWJMS- Anatomical Association, a whole body donor program. As program director, he has transformed the Anatomical Association from a small program that provided cadavers for RWJMS Gross Anatomy courses to one which now serves the important needs of clinical departments, graduate and undergraduate programs throughout the state of New Jersey. In the summer of 2013, Dr. Mulheron oversaw the acquisition of the Rutgers-New Jersey Medical School whole body donor program by the RWJMS-Anatomical Association, which is now the sole program of its kind in New Jersey.

Dr. Mulheron's research interests are related to finding innovative ways of delivering course content and improving the student experience in the gross anatomy lab. Recent examples include the production of short dissection videos, development on an on-line dissection guide and instituting a remix approach to student dissection teams.
