The competition involves Regional Brain Bees held throughout the United States and the world in January and February. Regional winners from the United States travel to Maryland to compete in the National Brain Bee March 4-5, 2012.

Prizes:

- **First Place Winner:** \$300 plus travel funds up to \$1500 for two to attend the National Brain Bee Competition in Maryland in March.
- **Second Place Winner:** \$200
- **Third Place Winner:** \$100
