

DIRECTIONS To MEB New Brunswick

By Automobile:

From the New Jersey Turnpike: Take Exit 9 (New Brunswick) and proceed to the right lane towards Rt. 18 North. Then get immediately in your left lane and continue to follow Rt. 18 North. Continue on 18 North and get into the right lane and look for the sign that reads **ALL EXITS**. Take Rt. 27 South (Albany Street/Princeton exit). Follow Rt. 27 South past the New Brunswick RR Station. At the 5th traffic light turn LEFT onto Joyce Kilmer Avenue. Then turn RIGHT at the first light onto Paterson Street to the parking deck which is on the left.

From Route 1: Take Rt. 18 North and follow directions above.

From Route 287: Take Exit 10 (Easton Ave - Rt. 527 - New Brunswick). Follow Rt. 527 (Easton Avenue) for about six miles to a T - Intersection (the New Brunswick Train Station will be on the left). Turn RIGHT onto Rt. 27 South (French Street). After passing under the railroad trestle, turn LEFT at Joyce Kilmer St. and RIGHT at the first light onto Paterson Street.

From Garden State Parkway: (From points north): Take Exit 130 (Rt. 1 South). Proceed about nine miles to Rt. 18 North. Follow Directions as listed above. (From points south): Exit onto New Jersey Turnpike South. Follow directions as listed above.

By Train:

Take the NJ Transit or Amtrak train to New Brunswick station. From main lobby, exit double doors. Turn right (pass flower shop) to the next corner. Cross over Easton Avenue to Little Albany Street. Building will be on left (one half block). Take stairs up to atrium and cross the atrium to the Medical Education Building (name above the doorway). Follow the directions below starting at the **.

Getting to the Medical Education Building (MEB) from the CAB parking deck:

Once parked, walk across the street to the lobby of the Clinical Academic Building. Go to your left in the building and walk to the end of the hall where there will be elevators on your right. Take the elevators to the third floor. When you get off the elevator straight ahead there will be a walking bridge, walk across the bridge and continue straight until you come to an atrium. If you continue walking next to the windows you will see double doors for the Medical Education Building (name above the doorway). Take the elevators to the second floor to the Department of Family Medicine (walk along the windowed hallway on your left and through the double doors). Take this hallway to end make a right and Room 259 is the first room on your right.
