OVERALL EDUCATIONAL GOAL OF ELECTIVE

To provide opportunity to enhance teaching skills and/or to receive support in developing a scholarly project, e.g., medical education instructional/evaluation materials or developing/editing a manuscript.

OBJECTIVES

Students will

- Develop individual goals and objectives.
- Review medical education literature relevant to their individual goals/objectives.

Students may

- Identify instructional methods and materials that lead to durable student learning, and engage in curricular development, pedagogical practice, and/or assessment activities.
- Design/progress on scholarly project in education.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

Each student will develop an individualized plan *prior* to the start of the elective; experiences for the elective will be arranged as possible during requested weeks. Students may prepare teaching and evaluation materials, review research relevant to medical education, progress on DIME and Independent Projects related to medical education, and assist in research conducted by the Office of Education/Cognitive Skills Program. Students will read medical education journals and maintain a reflective log of elective activities.

METHOD OF STUDENT EVALUATION

Supervising faculty will assess student performance based on achievement of individual objectives, and quality of reflective log. Students will self-assess performance in collaboration with supervising faculty.
