BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

Each student will develop an individualized plan *prior* to the start of the elective, and will meet regularly with Dr. Swee to discuss and modify the plan as appropriate throughout the course of the elective. Projects may be developed by the student or be one that is ongoing in the office of education or another unit within the medical school, as long as the projects are focused on medical education issues. Reading the medical education literature will be expected.

METHOD OF STUDENT EVALUATION

Dr. Swee will assess the student's performance based on achievement of the individual objectives. Students will also be asked to submit a written self-assessment of their performance.
