OVERALL EDUCATIONAL GOAL OF ELECTIVE

Students are offered the opportunity to work one on one with various radiology attendings and residents to create interactive online teaching modules using the Student PACS software system. Students will learn clinical radiology and gain experience in radiology education.

OBJECTIVES

Create two to three teaching modules a week suitable for publishing on the RWJMS Radiology or Anatomy teaching websites.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

Students will meet daily with either a resident or an attending to discuss a radiological study. Students will be given a format for their teaching modules, which they should use to help obtain relevant case information from their mentor. Students have the option of working at home on their personal computers or on designated hospital computers with the Student PACS software installed. Students have the option to attend resident conferences that relate to their modules.

METHOD OF STUDENT EVALUATION

Students will be evaluated on the quality of their finished cases and must create at least two teaching modules a week.
