**OBJECTIVES**

To prepare the student for the inpatient responsibilities attendant with the PG-1 year

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES**

The student will serve on a general and special care inpatient service in medicine performing essentially the duties of an intern, but with approximately one half the work load. The subintern will be assigned to an intern/resident team. The subintern will admit and manage patients, writing the official history and physical and progress notes under the supervision of the resident. The plans will be formulated by the subintern and his/her resident. Since students cannot write orders in New Jersey, the resident will write the orders agreed upon. He/she will attend conferences and attending rounds with the team. The student will be assigned a faculty preceptor for regular supervision.

**METHOD OF STUDENT EVALUATION**

Daily assessment by house officers and faculty. The preceptor will submit the evaluation after gathering information from others with whom the subintern has worked.
