OVERALL EDUCATIONAL GOAL OF ELECTIVE

OBJECTIVES: students will learn how to recognize and manage common GI disorders including constipation, GERD, and functional GI disorders

I. Patient care : students will be able to be involved in the care of outpatients. They will see new patients (approximately 6/day) and be observed as they obtain a focused history. They will be asked to create a DDX and plan. They will also observe follow up office visits and endoscopies.

II. Medical knowledge: Students will be asked to display their knowledge of common GI conditions such as constipation, GERD, and functional GI disorders among others via their interaction with new office visits. Guidelines form NASPGHAN will be provided as well as other reading materials.

III. Practice-based learning and improvement: students will be involved in daily discussions related to evidence based medicine

IV. Interpersonal and communication skills: Students will be observed as they obtain a history and given real time feedback on their interpersonal and communication skills.

V. Professionalism: students will be expected to arrive on time and dress appropriately. They should strive to have professional interactions with patients, their families and the office staff

VI. Systems-based Practice: students will learn the role of a consultant, and have exposure to issues related to insurance approval of medications and procedures.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES: STUDENTS WILL GET A HISTORY ON ALL NEW OFFICE PATIENTS SO AS TO RECOGNIZE/DIAGNOSE AND MANAGE COMMON GI CONDITIONS. THEY WILL ALSO OBSERVE AND DISCUSS FOLLOW UP PATIENTS AND OBSERVE ENDOSCOPIC PROCEDURES.
