### Overall Educational Goal of Elective:

The overall goal of this elective is to provide students with exposure to both pediatric and adult clinical urology. In this elective, they will be introduced to the breadth of urologic diseases, diagnostic workups, and treatments. Knowledge acquired will be relevant and applicable to students with interests in all fields of medicine.

### Objectives:

- I. Patient care: Students will learn about patient symptoms and common presentations associated with various urologic diseases.
- II. Medical knowledge:
- III. Students will learn about the epidemiology, pathophysiology, diagnostic workup, and treatment surrounding urologic diseases.
- IV. Practice-based learning and improvement: Students will participate in both group and self-directed learning via online lectures and independent reading assignments.
- V. Interpersonal and communication skills: Students will participate in interactive lectures by asking questions and responding to group polls.
- VI. Professionalism: Participating students will engage in truthful interaction with peers, and staff. They will demonstrate preparedness for meetings and will demonstrate attitudes & behaviors which convey respect for other students and faculty.
- VII. Systems-based Practice: Lectures will cover basic principles of clinical urology including when to obtain a urology consult, thereby emphasizing proper usage of health care resources.

**Brief Description of Activities:** Students will virtually attend daily lectures via WebEx. All lectures will be interactive, and students will have the opportunity to actively participate and ask questions. Some lessons will be accompanied by some additional reading.
