OVERALL EDUCATIONAL GOAL OF ELECTIVE

The goal of the elective is an understanding of the genito-urinary system pattern of diseases and an approach to treatment. The student will spend each day in the office, cystoscopy suite, and the operating room with one or more preceptors, either Drs. Rosenberg, Rossman, Latzko, Wedmid or Vukasin as assigned by the director.

OBJECTIVES

To see the practice of Urology first hand, what a Urologist does and to learn the basics.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

Primary activity is with the Urology resident at the hospital, assisting in the O.R., at the clinic and some time in the Urologist's office.

METHOD OF STUDENT EVALUATION

The method of evaluation will be left up to the preceptors; the quality of their workup of cases; their responses when discussing their patients on ward rounds; their acceptance of responsibility, demonstration of increasing skill in uroradiology, evidence of learning in cystoscopy and at the operating table and evidence of selective reading. They should be judged just as we would judge a resident.
