## Medical Education in Romania:

- Medical school: 6 years after high school
- Residency: varies depending on specialty (5 years Pediatrics; 3 years Family Medicine)

## Arad County Clinical Hospital: Pediatrics Department

- Visited patients aged 3-18 years with pediatric and family medicine residents
- Practiced physical exam skills
- Attended rounds with attending physician and residents
- Observed outpatient visits in the clinic
- Discussed lab results with residents
- Procedures observed: ultrasound, cardiac echo, spirometry, blood draws, arterial blood gas test

## Healthcare System Differences:

- Universal healthcare, lower costs

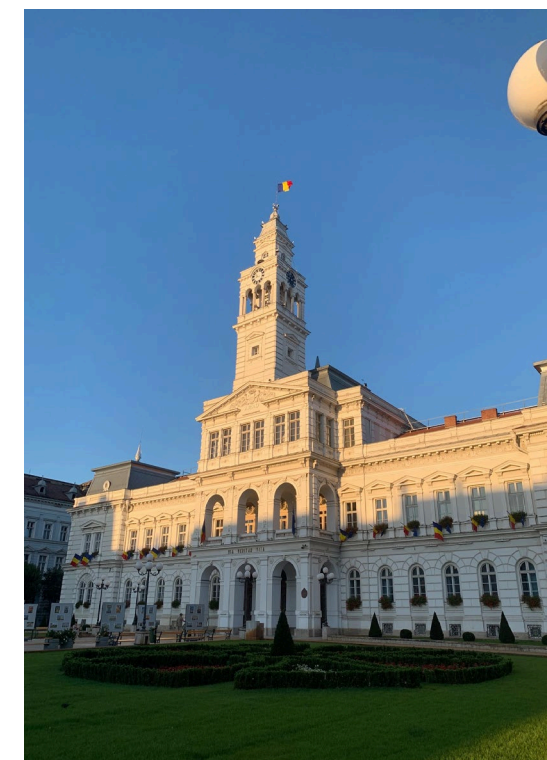
