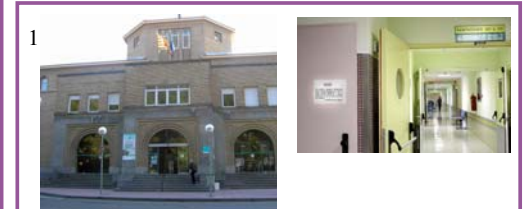
Global Health Program
