<u>Invasive Clinical procedures training-soft-body training program</u> (Silent Mentor Program)

This is an unembalmed body (soft body)-based invasive clinical skills training program. Hands-on practice of clinical procedures on human bodies provides gold opportunities of practical training. In addition, home visit before the class and interaction with donors' families at the beginning and at the end of the program add remarkable humanistic value to this professional skills training program. Donors are viewed as altruistic models. Interaction brings the good-will wishes of the donors and the solemn hearts of the families closer to the minds of trainees. Cultivation of empathy is a unique humanistic element of this training program.

Tube thoracostomy: insertion, fixation and removal
